What a summer. I guess the big news for the club, if you haven't heard by now, is that the storage garage behind the Hollyhock Station was destroyed by a storm earlier this summer. While the garage was a total loss the Hollyhock Station and the used car sales office escaped the storm with no damage! Kevin and Rick have been hard at work measuring and putting plans together to reconstruct a new storage building.

We have been informed that Buckstop Junction failed to provide insurance of the storage building so if the club decides rebuild we will have to fund it 100% ourselves. They had also informed us that the Hollyhock station was is drastically underinsured, with a replacement value of around \$5000. At the last Buckstop meeting the situations were discussed and the board apologizes for the oversight on the insurance. They have assured us that they will be looking into what a proper value of the Hollyhock Station should be and will fix the issue as soon as possible. However, because the storage building was a complete loss we will have to follow all current building codes. To put up a structure large enough to store a tanker, the grill, lawnmower and tents we will need to pour a floating slab; also we need to have a more distance between existing structures and the structure to be built. This means that the club will have to relocate where the storage building will be. Buckstop board did offer to let the club build a new storage building on the west end of our used car lot, which would fit building code and allow us all the room we would need.

August 8th is the makeup date for the Acres of Iron show. The schedule will be the same as the original date. So that means the show starts at 10:00am at the Eagles club on 26th street in Bismarck. The Roughrider Chevy Club will be holding their show on Sunday at the Elks club on Washington and Expressway in Bismarck. The two clubs are once again going in together for a grand prize for those who showed up to both shows.

The weekend after Acres is the Corn Feed at Buckstop Junction. As in past years we will be cooking burgers and dogs for the masses. Bring your classic car for the show and let's see if we can get the used car lot packed, also please bring a bag of ice for the coolers. Steve and Jo also wanted to remind everyone that they are having their traditional salmon feed for those who come to help at the Corn Feed.

Our next meeting will be 7:00 on Aug 20th at the Hollyhock Station, bring a chair and see you there!

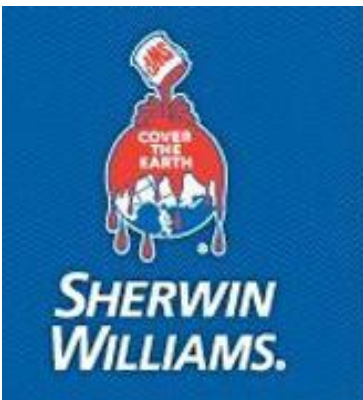
Old Business



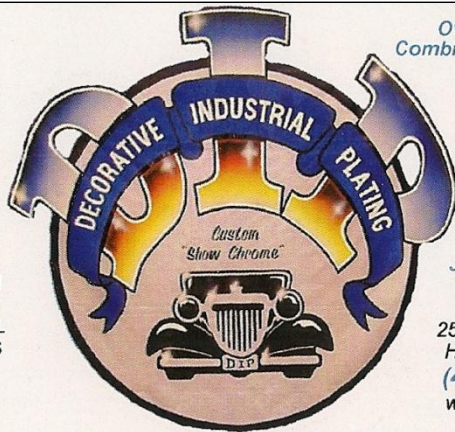

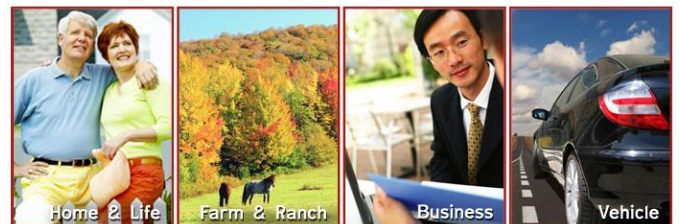
