2. Deceased member board: Will discuss at the November meeting.


### Committee Reports

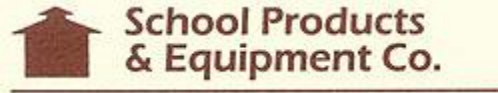

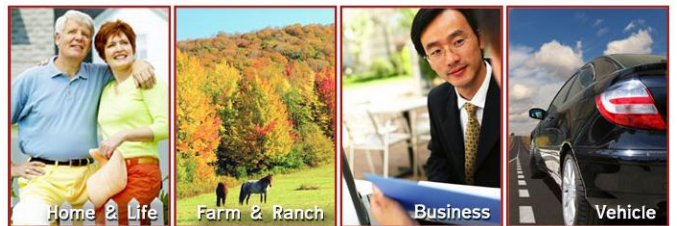
