5. Upcoming events are on the website.

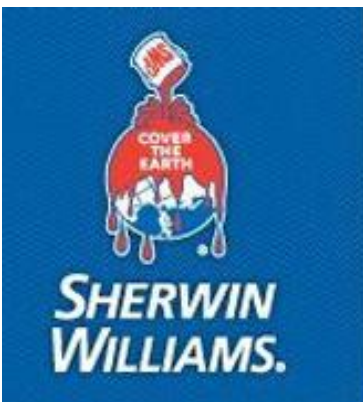
Old Business



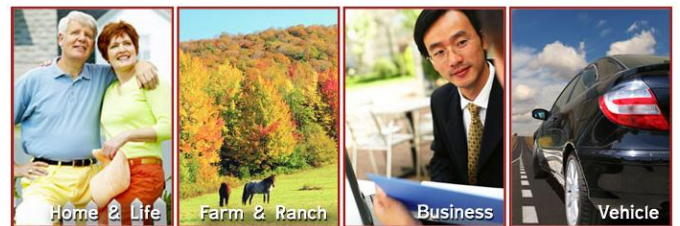
