Old Business

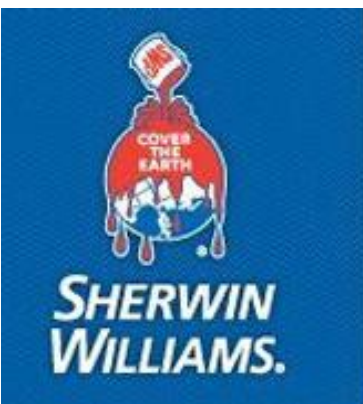
1. Corn Feed: Was a great day and made money for the club. Gave rides in vintage cars.

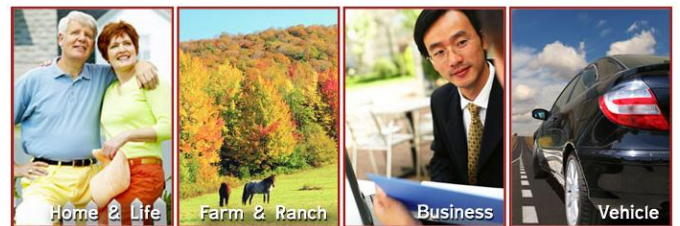
